

Applications are being accepted from licensed and qualified Contractors for the RIHousing LeadSafe Homes Program

Qualifications & Requirements:

In order to participate in the RIHousing LeadSafe Homes Program, contractors must provide certain information and maintain means of communication as follows:

- A. A completed application.
- B. A minimum of 2 years construction business experience, or demonstrated equivalent.
- C. A copy of their current registration with the RI Contractor Registration & Licensing Board.
- D. A copy of their current Rhode Island Lead Hazard Reduction Contractor license.
- E. A copy of current insurance certificates with RIHousing as Certificate Holder.
 - i. General Liability Insurance
 - ii. Workers Compensation Insurance, or other acceptable Insurance Waiver*
- F. The contractor must maintain an active cell phone.
- G. The contractor must maintain an active e-mail address capable of receiving documents.
- H. A copy of R.I. Lead Hazard Reduction licenses for all staff adequate to complete the contract.
- I. A list of sub-contractors, vendors and financial institutions that support your business.
- J. A copy of sub-contractor's documentation as required in C, D, & E, above.

2. **New Contractors:**

- A. New contractors must meet all requirements listed above.
- B. Complete the application process and provide references.
- C. After all requirements have been met; a construction specialist will be assigned to act as Mentor to the new contractor.
- D. Each new contractor will participate in the Program on a probationary status until three lead hazard reduction projects have been successfully completed.
- E. During the probation period, the new contractor may be suspended and/or dismissed at any time for lack of performance, including administrative processes and/or property production.
